# Layout Garden Design Plans

### Layout & Zoning Concept

- The garden shape triangular and slightly awkward which can make it difficult to maximise the space
- The concept behind the design is to move the key functions for enjoying the garden (lounging, eating enjoying flowers) away from the house
- This means you can both utilise all of the space in the garden more frequently but also change the perspective when sat on the dining patio or in the slightly shaded 'lounge' area to look across the different planting views of the garden
- To achieve this the garden has been split into zones to provide different reasons to move into each space of the garden. There are two relaxing areas, one for dining/cooking and one for lounging in the day or evening with a fire pit
- The planting is designed to be completely raise off the ground with the entire border wrapping around the whole garden in a raise bed, approx. 0.5m high. This is designed make each relaxing area feel separate and private. The raise bed isn't essential if budget is restrictive, but will provide a more cosy feel to the garden
- The bed nearest the house has been designed to improve the view from the patio doors (assumption is this is a bedroom), which will look onto planting rather than hard landscaping. The kitchen door leads straight out onto the path to access the cooking/dining area

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## **Garden Conditions**

- Garden direction: West facing
- Sun levels: Most of garden in full sun
- Soil type: dry, sandy
- Soil moisture: Well drained, moist but well drained
- Garden size: 10 x 9 at widest points
- Other information: n/a

**Option 1 - Budget Friendly** 

Charcoal/anthracite block pavers. Dark grey to contrast with lighter dining paving

Size: 200 x 60cm

#### Option 2 - Upgrade

Natural Limestone in dark grey

Size: 200 x 50cm





# Dining Area/Path

#### **Option 1 - Budget Friendly**

Keep square pavers along side house. Remove one row and repurpose for dining area. Purchase additional as required

#### **Option 2 - Upgrade**

Natural sandstone in grey to compliment the natural planting scheme.


